



Kitten Maintenance Programme

DIET:

- Kitten Growth formulation
- Ad lib feeding of dry food unless weight gain excessive, then 2 meals per day
- Change to adult food at 12 months of age.

VACCINATIONS:

- Three vaccinations at 8 weeks, 12 weeks and 16 weeks.
- We recommend vaccinating against Feline Herpes Virus, Feline Calicivirus, Feline Parvovirus, Feline Leukaemia Virus
- Annual revaccination thereafter

DEWORMING PROGRAMME:

- We recommend spot-on Revolution or Advocate monthly.
- If you choose not to use these products then give a worming tablet as follows:
- Every 2 weeks until 12 weeks of age, then once a month until 6 months old
- Then we recommend deworming your cat every 3 months for life.

FLEA CONTROL & HEARTWORM PREVENTION:

Spot on, monthly application to the back of your cat's neck.

The following recommended products kill all stages of the flea lifecycle on your cat and in the environment. It is important to treat all pets in the household.

- Revolution - fleas, heartworm, intestinal worms, ear mites
- Advocate - fleas, heartworm, intestinal worms, ear mites
- Frontline - fleas only
- Advantage - fleas only

MICROCHIP INSERTION:

Lifetime, permanent identification if your cat is lost or stolen

Performed at six months of age, prior to first heat for female - Can be performed earlier if necessary
